## Program Cost

### Explanation of Costs

The Mountains to Sound Greenway Trust works hard to provide the best possible value to our school partners. Our goal is to remove barriers preventing students from accessing the outdoors, not to create new ones. To make this happen, we subsidize the cost of our program through a combination of gifts and grants from generous donors and supporters.

All of our curriculums, unless otherwise noted in their description, include five parts that build upon each other to create a truly meaningful learning experience for your students.

### Program Fees

Our program fees are per class and are based on a school's percentage of students participating in the National School Lunch Program (a.k.a. "their free and reduced lunch rate") as defined by the OSPI website. To find out what your school's percentage is, visit the OSPI Washington State Report Card.

## Transportation

### Field Study Trips

Each year, King County Metro provides a limited number of public buses through their Wheels to Water program to transport classes to field study trips. To be eligible for a Wheels to Water bus, schools must have a free and reduced rate of 25% or higher. If you are interested in applying, please contact us as soon as possible.



### Stewardship Events

Each year, the Mountains to Sound Greenway Trust makes available a limited amount of funding to reimburse schools participating in service-learning stewardship events for bus rental costs. To be eligible for reimbursement, schools must have a free and reduced lunch rate of 50% or higher. Please apply for reimbursement at time of registration and, if approved, be sure to submit the receipt(s) to our main office no later than one month after your event, by email to [Jessica.Adair@mtsgreenway.org](mailto:Jessica.Adair@mtsgreenway.org). Schools that register for Restoring the Balance are not eligible for bus reimbursement.
